

# **Geraldton City Speedway Code of Conduct**

## **Effective July 1<sup>st</sup> 2007**

Our speedway aims to provide a safe and friendly environment in which to race. To that end any/or of the following will not be tolerated at our track

1. Abuse of an official, driver, or crew
2. Entering the track without authorisation e.g. in the case of a rollover.
3. Any action found bringing the speedway into disrepute
4. Drinking alcohol outside of the licensed bar area on race nights.
5. Smoking outside of the designated smoking areas in the pits.
6. Non compliance to the wearing of appropriate clothing and footwear in the pits will result in immediate compliance or ejection from the pit area. Refusing to leave the pit area and/or comply to the clothing standard will result in penalties. Dress code to apply start of scrutineering onwards.
7. All persons in the pit area may be subjected to random alcohol/drug testing. Green book penalties will apply.
8. Disrespect of the rules, officials, other cars and drivers while racing. Drivers involved will be cautioned initially, penalties may apply for repeat offences.

## **Penalties**

Drivers are responsible for their crew's actions

First offence fifty dollars, plus one race meeting suspension for associated driver

Subsequent offences. Penalty will be doubled.

All fines will be authorised by the committee and substantiated in writing prior to the next calendared race meeting. No person with unpaid fines owed to the Geraldton Speedway will be eligible to enter the pit area until the outstanding amount is paid..
